Subject : Stakeholders Meeting for preparation of City Development Plan for Bangalore under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM)

Government of India (GoI) with an objective of integrated development of urban infrastructure services has initiated JNNURM. JNNURM is being set up with an outlay of Rs fifty thousand crores and would cover sixty three cities in the next seven years. The

cities, in order to avail the funds available, would be required to prepare City Development Plans (CDPs) and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for the identified projects. The toolkits developed for preparation of CDPs and DPRs are available at the website www.urbanindia.nic.in.

KUIDFC has been nominated by Urban Development Department (UDD), Government of Karnataka (GoK) as the State Level Nodal Agency and would oversee the process. Development plans have been prepared by various agencies for Bangalore, setting out the infrastructure projects that could be undertaken and the estimated investment requirements. These plans have been prepared by Urban First and Centre for Symbiosis of Technology, Environment & Management after an interaction with various stakeholders, but need to be harmonized under a city – wide Vision, for the purposes of JNNURM. This has been assigned to iDeCK.

In this connection, an interaction with the stakeholders is proposed to be held on March 15, 2006 to discuss the following:

1. A perspective and a shared vision for the city,
2. Institutional framework including the organizational structure with respect to obligations towards service delivery and
3. Compilation of the projects identified for implementation, prepared by various agencies

The stakeholder interaction would be held on Wednesday the 15th of March 2006 at 11:00 AM at Conference Hall, KSRTC Central Office, Shanthinagar, Bangalore.

You are requested to kindly attend the meeting personally and share with us your views and observations on the same.
