

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA**

Sub: Formation of a Unified Metropolitan Transport for Mysore to facilitate implementation of Urban Transport Programmes and Projects and integrated Urban Transport System - reg.

**READ:-**

**PREAMBLE:-**

In G.O.dated.8-3-2007 read at (1) above. The State Government have accorded sanction for creation of State Directorate of Urban Development Transport(DULT) under the Urban Development Department with the intended objective of insuring integration of Transport Planning and Development of Transport Infrastructure in Urban Areas.

In the letter dated.12-1-2009, the Government of India has stated that Urban Areas, which are emerging as powerful engines of growth, are solely in need of a transport system that facilitates easy flow of goods and services and human mobility to support specified categories and levels of economic activities. Development of such sufficient systems can attract investments, trigger, economic growth, create jobs and reduce pollution. Therefore, National Urban Transport Policy(NUTP) has been drafted to ensure safe, affordable, quick, comfortable, reliable and sustainable access for the growing number of city residents to jobs, education, recreation and such other needs within our cities. National Urban Transport Policy(NUTP) stipulates designation of nodal department in the State Government for

Urban Transport. Hence, Directorate of Urban Transport has been created and National Urban Transport Policy(NUTP) also recommends setting up of Unified Urban Transport Authorities(UMTA's) in million plus cities.

Unified Metropolitan Transport Authorities(UMTA's) to facilitate more coordinated planning and implementation of Urban Transport Programmes and Projects and integrated management of urban transport systems.

Mysore being the second largest city in Karnataka and a major tourist centre, is one of the two cities selected for JNNURM funding in Karnataka. As per 2001 census-population of Mysore city was 7,87,179. In Mysore with decadal urban population growth for 1991-2001 being 29.74% . Migration of people from rural area being a continuous trend. Mysore population is projected at 10, 23,332 for the year 2010 considering a decadal population growth of 30% for 2001-2011.

As Mysore is emerging as a million plus city, the State Government considered it necessary to create a Unified Urban Transport Authority for the city of Mysore to be called as "Mysore City Urban Land Transport Authority". It will function as an umbrella organization to coordinate planning and implementation of Urban Transport Programme Projects and provide an integrated management structure. All land transport system(excluding railways) in the Mysore Local Planning Area are brought

under the purview of Mysore City Land Transport Authority. Hence the following order;

Under the circumstances explained above, Government are pleased to sanction for the creation of Unified Metropolitan Transport Authority(UMTA) for the City of Mysore to be called as "Mysore City Land Transport Authority" and Government are also pleased to set up a Committee under the chairmanship of the Secretary, Urban Development Department, comprising of the following members.

The function of MCLTA shall be as follows:

1. To co-ordinate all land transport matters in the Mysore Local Planning Area.
2. To prepare master plan for transport infrastructure based on the Comprehensive Traffic and Transportation study for Mysore.
3. To oversee implementation of CTPP and all transportation projects.
4. To appraise and recommend transportation and infrastructure projects related to assistance.
5. To function as empowered committee for all urban transportation projects related to Mysore Local Planning Area.
6. To initiate action for a regulatory framework for all land transport systems in Mysore Local Planning Area.
7. To initiate measures to implement common ticketing system wherever possible.
8. To take any other decision for integration of urban transport, land use planning and implementation of projects.
9. All Urban Transport related projects like road widening, flyovers, underpasses etc., need to be cleared by MCLTA before they are taken up for implementation.
10. KUIDFC release funds only to these transport related projects approved by MCLTA.
11. Any other functions entrusted by State and Central Government from time to time.
